How to add links back to your site.

Before you start you need to copy the addresses of your website pages and paste them into a word document. You also need to make a note of which address links to which page.



1 Login and go to dashboard if not already there.

2 Find the button for **Layout** and click

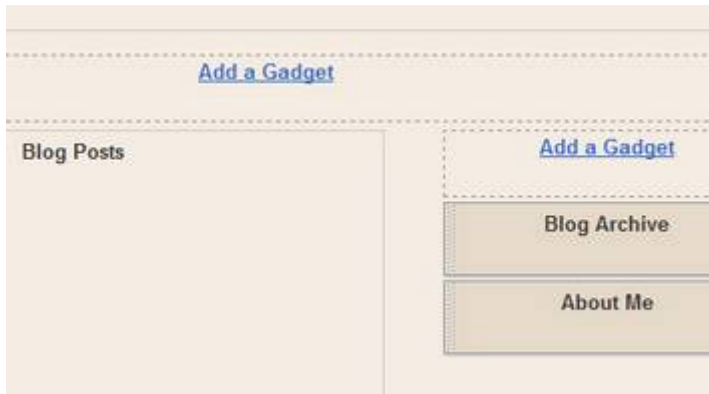

3 Make sure you are on **Page Elements**



4 depending on the template you have used there will be several areas which include a link **Add a Gadget**.

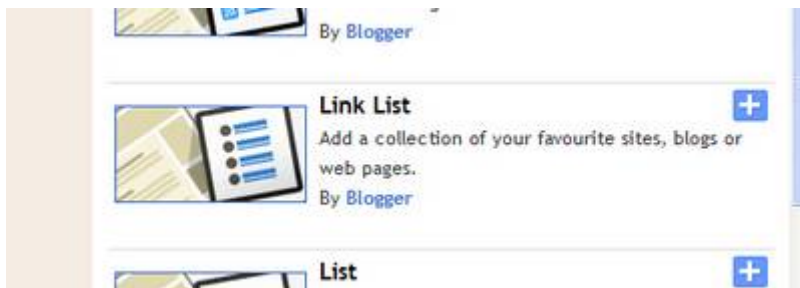


5 select one and click the link.

6 A new window will open with a selection of gadgets.



7 Scroll down until you get to **Link List**.



8 Click the **plus sign** or the picture to open The **Configure Link List** window.

10 In the **New Site URL** box copy and paste from your word document the web address of the page.

If it is your home page it will just be your domain name eg **http://www.yourname.co.uk** if another page it will be **http://www.yourname.co.uk/something.htm**

The URL must have the http:// before the www... and make sure you do not put http:// in twice.
