How to add a slideshow by importing a Flickr or Photobucket photo album.

This is not as simple as it seems but you can get it to work eventually.

1 Login and go to dashboard if not already there.

2 Find the button for **Layout** and click

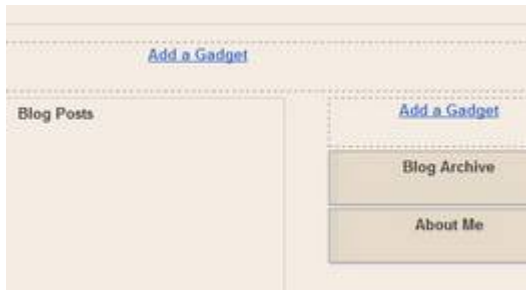

3 Make sure you are on **Page Elements**



4 depending on the template you have used there will be several areas which include a link **Add a Gadget**.

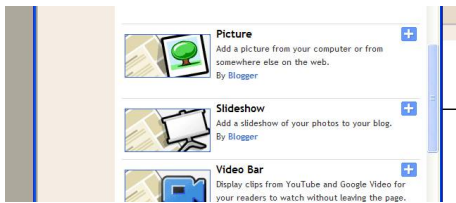


5 select one and click the link.

6 A new window will open with a selection of gadgets.



7 Scroll down until you get to **Slideshow**.




8 Click the **plus sign** or the picture to add the Slideshow. The Blogger Configure Slideshow window will open.




9 This is the point it gets a bit tricky click arrow in **Source** Select **OTHER**. (ignore the preset options they did not work for us)

10 Minimise Configure Slideshow window, Open a new Browser Tab or Browser Window and go to your Flickr or other Photo gallery.

Look for a RSS Feed link or an icon like this  click the link or icon. A new page should open which should show your photos. The address in the address bar is the Feed URL.



11 Maximise the Configure Slideshow window and copy the address into the Feed URL box in the Blogger Configure Slideshow window see below.

12 Set the speed and other options click **Save**.

Note when we viewed blog we got a generic **photo slide show**.

To get our own photos we had to click on edit in the slideshow area, in the Add and Arrange Page Elements page and then click save again in the Configure Slideshow window.
